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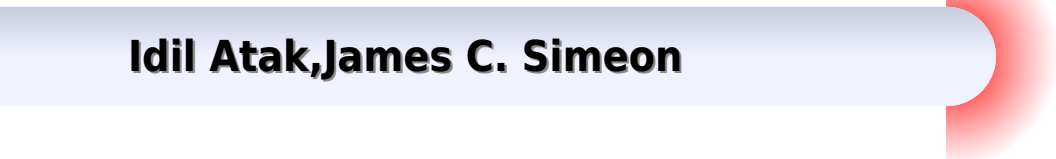

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México Beyond 1968 Jaime M. Pensado, Enrique C. Ochoa, 2018-09-18 *México Beyond 1968* examines the revolutionary organizing and state repression that characterized Mexico during the 1960s and 1970s. The massacre of students in Mexico City in October 1968 is often considered the defining moment of this period. The authors in this volume challenge the centrality of that moment by looking at the broader story of struggle and repression across Mexico during this time. *México Beyond 1968* complicates traditional narratives of youth radicalism and places urban and rural rebellions within the political context of the nation's Dirty Wars during this period. The book illustrates how expressions of resistance developed from the ground up in different regions of Mexico including Chihuahua, Guerrero, Jalisco, Mexico City, Puebla, and Nuevo León. Movements in these regions took on a variety of forms including militant strikes, land invasions, cross-country marches, independent forums, popular organizing, and urban and rural guerrilla uprisings. *México Beyond 1968* brings together leading scholars of Mexican studies today. They share their original research from Mexican archives partially opened after 2000 and now closed again to scholars, and they offer analysis of this rich primary source material including interviews, political manifestos, newspapers, and human rights reports. By centering on movements throughout Mexico, *México Beyond 1968* underscores the deep-rooted histories of inequality and the frustrations with a regime that monopolized power for decades. It challenges the conception of the Mexican state as exceptional and underscores and refocuses the centrality of the 1968 student movement. sociolinguistics specifically how neoliberalism inequality and social class mediate language in society issues After the preface in which the author sets the scene for the content of the book Chapter 1 is an extensive though selective review of sociolinguistics research which has been framed as political economic in orientation The chapter concludes that such research generally contains little in the way of thorough and in depth coverage of the key ideas and conceptual frameworks said to undergird it With this consideration in mind Chapters 2 3 and 4 are organised around in depth discussions of respectively political economy as a general disciplinary frame neoliberalism as the variegated variety of capitalism dominant in the world today and stratification inequality and social class as phenomena intrinsic to capitalism which in the neoliberal era have come to the fore as key issues Drawing directly on the background provide in Chapters 2 4 Chapters 5 and 6 explore two distinct political economy informed lines of research on the one hand the neoliberal citizen and on the other hand discursive class warfare The book ends with an epilogue addressing issues arising around political economy in sociolinguistics

Michigan Government, Politics, and Policy John S Klemanski, David A Dulio, 2017-08-02 The State of Michigan has experienced both tremendous growth and great decline in its history After many decades of growth up to the 1950s a wide variety of challenges had to be confronted by citizens and all levels of government in Michigan The late 20th and early 21st centuries have seen pockets of growth but also long term economic decline in several areas in the state As one example steep economic decline in major industrialized cities such as Detroit Flint and Pontiac led to increased unemployment rates and flight from the state as residents sought jobs elsewhere Michigan was in fact the only state in the union to experience net population loss between 2000 and 2010 At the same time emergencies such as the Detroit bankruptcy and the Flint water crisis have captured the attention of the national and international media focusing the spotlight on the responses successful or unsuccessful by state and local government As the state continues to deal with many of these challenges Michiganders more than ever need a clear picture of how their state's political institutions actors and processes work To that end this book provides a comprehensive analysis of Michigan's politics and government that will help readers better understand the state's history and its future prospects Chapters elucidate the foundational aspects of the state's government the Michigan Constitution and intergovernmental relations its political institutions the state legislature governor and court system its politics political parties and elections and its public policy education economic development and budget and fiscal policy The book's four themes historical context decline responses to challenges and state local government relations run throughout and are buttressed by coverage of recent events Moreover they are brought together in a compelling chapter with a particular focus on the Flint water crisis An ideal fit for courses on state and local government this thorough well written text will also appeal to readers simply interested in learning more about the inner workings of government in the Great Lakes State

Race and Ethnicity in English Language Teaching Christopher Joseph Jenks, 2017-08-14 This book examines racism and racialized discourses in the ELT profession in South Korea The book is

informed by a number of different critical approaches to race and discourse and the discussions contained in the chapters offer one way of exploring how the ELT profession can be understood from such perspectives. Observations made are based on the understanding that racism should not be viewed as individual acts of discrimination but rather as a system of social structures. While the book is principally concerned with language teaching and learning in South Korea, the findings are situated in a wider discussion of race and ethnicity in the global ELT profession. The book makes the following argument: White normativity is an ideological commitment and a form of racialized discourse that comes from the social actions of those involved in the ELT profession; this normative model or ideal standard constructs a system of racial discrimination that is founded on White privilege, saviorism, and neoliberalism. Drawing on a wide range of data sources, this book is a must read for anyone interested in critically examining ELT.

The Geneva Papers Christophe Courbage, 2016-04-29. The Color of Civics Matthew D. Nelsen, 2023. Generations of Americans dating back

to the nation's founding have regarded schools as essential for developing the knowledge and civic values necessary for sustaining democracy. Yet as Matthew D. Nelsen argues in *The Color of Civics*, traditional approaches to civic education are not living up to their promise for many students, particularly students of color from disadvantaged communities. How do we prepare an increasingly diverse generation of Americans for full participation in public life? Drawing on lessons from students and teachers in Chicago, *The Color of Civics* reimagines the democratic purpose of civic education. Nelsen's findings challenge some of the most widely cited civic education research, arguing that the content of traditional civic education courses privileges the political experiences of white political actors and in turn contributes to divergent political behaviors and participatory outcomes across racial and ethnic groups. He presents a new approach to civic education that aims to foster political empowerment by centering historically grounded conversations about current events as well as critical categories of knowledge: those that highlight the agency and grassroots political action of marginalized groups. This approach increases rates of intended political participation among young people of color and heightens political empathy among white youth. Nelsen also highlights the agency of teachers in processes of socialization, exploring how their attitudes and lived experiences drive the implementation of more empowering civic learning environments. By taking the histories and lived experiences of marginalized communities seriously, *The Color of Civics* asserts that civics courses can become spaces where young people begin to recognize their own agency, develop empathy, and define the terms of their own political participation. Including novel empirical research and an evidence-based analysis, Nelsen provides practical and useful advice for policymakers that cuts through the noise to focus on what works.
