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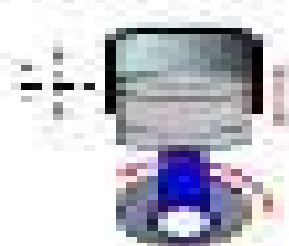


Figure 1: A plot of the function $y = \sin(x)$

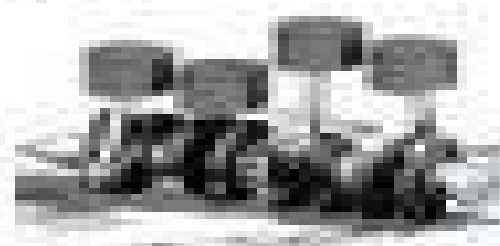


Figure 2: A plot of the function $y = \sin(x)$
