I will be providing the support of a criminologist to the Greenville Police Department. The main objective of this initiative by the Greenville Police Department is to use data and theory to help guide their decision regarding how property crimes are addressed in the city and determine the best course of action for their department. The purpose of this memorandum is to provide an overview of what my roles and responsibilities will be while providing criminological support to Greenville.

As a crime analyst, I can examine any information or statistics relating to the current crimes taking place all around the city. Computer proficiency is required to search and access multiple databases to obtain the relevant data needed to decide the best course of action to address the issue of criminal activity in Greenville. To establish whether cases that have been tried have precedents in common, I may be able to use my skills to identify patterns between criminal activities and perpetrators. Additionally, I can help come up with a plan to avoid similar crimes from happening and to help capture the perpetrator by identifying their possible next move or attack; also know how to write reports and have great organizational abilities.

Criminologists are skilled in examining facts and statistics from crimes that have been committed in the past and present. They may "gain a better understanding of why and how these crimes are happening so they can try to reduce and prevent similar events from happening again in the future" with the use of this information. An action plan to attempt to stop the crime from happening again might be developed by a criminologist after studying the property crimes that happened in Greenville.

The chief of the department, John Todt, will be the specific people with whom I will work. Along with Captain Mike Bixbey, Susan Flores, the deputy police chief, and I will collaborate on projects. Additionally, I will collaborate with the city's part-time crime analyzer. These people will be able to provide me with access to arrest information, police reports, and hot-spot mapping statistics. Additionally, it would be beneficial to maintain contact with Executive Director Brayden Usoro to have access to any paperwork on previous community gathering. I'll be able to
