

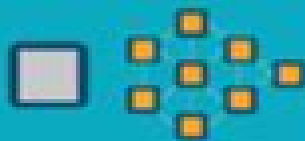
Types of automated testing

Software testing is not restricted to a single type, and multiple test types can be applied simultaneously or performed in succession.



REGRESSION TESTING

ensures that new code doesn't break existing code. It is typically repeated after each build.



A UNIT TEST

checks specific parts of a code base. A successful unit test signals that the code compiled and executed as intended.



SMOKE TESTS

generally determine whether an application still functions properly after a new build. A passed smoke test provides the go-ahead for more detailed testing.



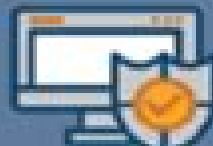
API AND INTEGRATION TESTS

validate the interaction of requests and responses for the app's APIs, such as with databases, mainframes and web services.



USER INTERFACE AND INPUT/OUTPUT TESTS

can check a command-line interface, GUI or button-press sequences. I/O testing basically transforms input data into output data.



SECURITY TESTS

check authorization behaviors and common attack vectors. Vulnerability testing on the code base checks for known flaws and is usually done via penetration testing.



PERFORMANCE TESTS

measure an application's KPIs, such as computing load, traffic levels and scalability. They are meant to push an app to its limits.



ACCEPTANCE TESTS

validate that software meets its criteria and that the project is done.
