6. Defend the claim that ribosomes are the most essential organelle in the cell. In your reasoning, include evidence of at least 3 organelles that support the ribosome in accomplishing its function for the cell.
7. Compare and contrast the structure and function of a plant cell and an animal cell.
8. Predict the consequences of the failure or absence of an organelle inside a eukaryotic cell.
