LACK OF CLEAR GUIDELINES

 Unlike some other qualitative methods, thematic analysis lacks a set of prescribed, standardized rules or guidelines. This flexibility can lead to inconsistencies in how researchers apply the method, potentially affecting the rigor and quality of the analysis.
