The civil was began primarily as a result of the long-standing controversy over the enclavement of black people. Was broke out in April. 1861 when secretional forces attacked Fort Sunter in South Carolina shortly after Alterhain Lincoln had been inaugurated as the President of the United States. The lovalists of the Union in the North, which also included some prographically western and southern states, proclaimed support for the Constitution. They faced secretionists of the Confederate States in the South, who advocated for states' rights in order to uphold slavery. Of the 34 U.S. states in February 1865, seven Southern slave states were declared by their state governments to have secreted from the country, and the Confederate States of America was organized in rebellion against the U.S. constitutional povenment. The Confederacy grew to control at least a majority of femiliary in eleven states, and it claimed the additional states of Kentucky and Missouri by assertions from native secretionists fleeing Usion authority. These states were given full representation in the Condederate Congress throughout the Civil War. The two remaining "slave" states, Delaware and Maryland, were invited to join the Confederacy, but nothing substantial developed due to intervention by federal troops. The Confederate states were never diplomatically recognized as a sount entity by the government of the United States, nor by that of any fineign. country. The states-
