The contributions of this thesis are within the area of motion planning and feedback control for long tractor trailer combinations operating at low speeds in closed and unstructured environments It includes development of motion planning and feedback control frameworks structured design tools for guaranteeing closed loop stability and experimental validation of the proposed solutions through simulations lab and field experiments Even though the primary application in this work is tractor trailer vehicles many of the proposed approaches can with some adjustments also be used for other systems such as drones and ships The developed sampling based motion planning algorithms are based upon the probabilistic closed loop rapidly exploring random tree CL RRT algorithm and the deterministic lattice based motion planning algorithm It is also proposed to use numerical optimal control offline for precomputing libraries of optimized maneuvers as well as during online planning in the form of a warm started optimization step To follow the motion plan several predictive path following control approaches are proposed with different computational complexity and performance Common for these approaches are that they use a path following error model of the vehicle for future predictions and are tailored to operate in series with a motion planner that computes feasible paths. The design strategies for the path following approaches include
