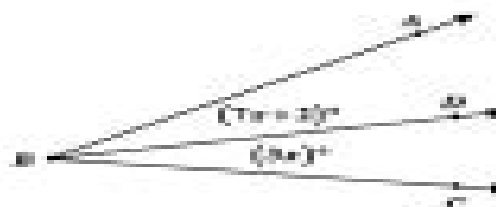
2. In the diagram below,  $\angle DBF$ ,  $\angle EBC$ , and  $\angle EBA$  are right angles.
