Why do the gravediggers say that if Ophelia wasn't rich, she wouldn't receive a Christian burial?	They say this because they believe she drowned herself on purpose, therefore sinning since she shortened her own life. Because she is rich, she is given more leeway in what kind of burial she receives.
Answer Hamlet's question in your own words: "Has this fellow no feeling of his business that sings at grave-making" (5.1.68-9).	I believe the man is less sensitive to his work than others, since he is surrounded by symbols and images of death every day. Digging a grave is a normal day for him, and seeing another person die just adds another task to his to-do list. Also, singing may take off some of the melancholy feeling that comes with the profession.
Hamlet makes an <u>allusion</u> to the Biblical figure Cain, the "first murderer," to make what point about the gravedigger's attitude?	He does this to show the carelessness the gravedigger treats the skull with, throwing it around as though it is not valuable and is the skull of a true evil-doer.
As the grave diggers remove various skulls, what is Hamlet's reaction?	Hamlet gets defensive for the lives of the people whose skulls are being tossed around like nothing. He wonders if they were somebody significant, and if this scene is all their life amounted to.
Describe Hamlet's reaction to the presentation of Yorick's skull.	Hamlet reminisces on what he knew about Yorick and the good times he spent with him. He is sorrowful that Yorick's life, which brought enjoyment into his, ended up here in the dirt, his skull being carelessly thrown around.
