The Changing Practices of International Law Tanja Aalberts, Thomas Gammeltoft-Hansen, 2018-04-05 With more than 158 000 treaties and some 125 judicial organisations international law has become an inescapable factor in world politics since the Second World War. In recent years however international law has also been increasingly challenged as states are voicing concerns that it is producing unintended effects and accuse international courts of judicial activism. This book provides an important corrective to existing theories of international law by focusing on how states respond to increased legalisation and rely on legal expertise to manoeuvre within and against international law. Through a number of case studies covering a wide range of topical issues such as surveillance, environmental regulation, migration and foreign investments the book argues that the expansion and increased institutionalisation of international law itself have created the structural premise for this type of politics of international law. More international law paradoxically increases states' political room of manoeuvre in world society.

Decolonization and Conflict Martin Thomas, Gareth Curless, 2017-06-15 Insurgency-based irregular warfare typifies armed conflict in the post-Cold War age. For some years now western and other governments have struggled to contend with ideologically driven guerrilla movements, religiously inspired militias and systematic targeting of civilian populations. Numerous conflicts of this type are rooted in experiences of empire breakdown. Yet few multi-empire studies of decolonisation's violence exist. *Decolonization and Conflict* brings together expertise on a variety of different cases to offer new perspectives on the colonial conflicts that engulfed Europe's empires after 1945. The contributors analyse multiple forms of colonial counter-insurgency from the military engagement of anti-colonial movements to the forced removal of civilian populations and the application of new doctrines of psychological warfare. Contributors to the collection also show how insurgencies' propaganda and methods of action were inherently transnational and inter-connected. The resulting study is a vital contribution to our understanding of contested decolonization. It emphasises the global connections at work and reveals the contemporary resonances of both anti-colonial insurgencies and the means devised to counter them. It is essential reading for students and scholars of empire, decolonization and asymmetric warfare.

Islam and the Liberal State Stephen H. Jones, 2020-11-26 National identity and liberal democracy are recurrent themes in debates about Muslim minorities in the West. Britain is no exception with politicians responding to claims about Muslims' lack of integration by mandating the promotion of fundamental British values including democracy and individual liberty. This book engages with both these themes, addressing the lack of understanding about the character of British Islam and its relationship to the liberal state. It charts a gradual but

decisive shift in British institutions concerned with Islamic education Islamic law and Muslim representation since Muslims settled in the UK in large numbers in the 1950s Based on empirical research including interviews undertaken over a ten year period with Muslims and analysis of public events organized by Islamic institutions Stephen Jones challenges claims about the isolation of British Islamic organizations and shows that they have decisively shaped themselves around British public and institutional norms He argues that this amounts to the building of a distinctive British Islam Using this narrative the book makes the case for a variety of liberalism that is open to the expression of religious arguments in public and to associations between religious groups and the state It also offers a powerful challenge to claims about the insularity of British Islamic institutions by showing how the national orientation of Islam called for by British policymakers is in fact already happening

three quarters of the Arctic population In total the sea and land surface area of the Russian Arctic is about 6 million square kilometres Economically as much as 20 percent of Russia s GDP and its total exports is generated north of the Arctic Circle In terms of resources about 95 percent of its gas 75 percent of its oil 96 percent of its platinum 90 percent of its nickel and cobalt and 60 percent of its copper reserves are found in Arctic and Sub Arctic regions Add to this the riches of the continental shelf seabed and waters ranging from rare earth minerals to fish stocks After a spike of aggressive rhetoric when Russia planted its flag in the Arctic seabed in 2007 Moscow has attempted to strengthen its position as a key factor in developing an international consensus concerning a region where its relative advantages are manifest despite its diminishing military technological and human capacities **Tigary: The Panarchy of War** Mirjam Van Reisen,Munyaradzi

Asymmetric Crisis in Europe and Possible Futures Johannes Jäger, Elisabeth Springler, 2015-04-10 The crisis in Europe is often discussed as a crisis of European integration or a crisis of national economies within Europe Both the methodological Europeanism and methodological nationalism miss out the important links between economic and political processes at different spatial scales within Europe and therefore asymmetries and phenomena of uneven development In addition a discussion of possible scenarios which systematically addresses the implications of anti crisis policies is missing This volume seeks to close this gap by systematically integrating the analysis of economic policy or technical solutions to the crisis within a broader framework of political economy It argues that combining critical political economy approaches and post Keynesian perspectives allows for a systematic understanding of the economic and political dimensions of the crisis Although both approaches have the capacity to deal with asymmetries and uneven development the heterogeneity in Europe has been an often largely neglected dimension of analysis However this recent crisis has shown that this is an essential dimension which has to be addressed in order to better understand the dynamics of European development and integration Hence this book aims to deal with asymmetries in Europe and to bridge the gap between the two perspectives This work will initiate an integrative debate that is crucial for a deeper understanding of the current crisis and is an important resource for all students and scholars of IPE European political economy and European politics

On Bicycles Evan Friss, 2019-05-07 Subways and yellow taxis may be the icons of New York transportation but it is the bicycle that has the longest claim to New York s streets two hundred years and counting Never has it taken to the streets without controversy 1819 was the year of the city s first bicycle and also its first bicycle ban Debates around the bicycle s place in city life have been so persistent not just because of its many uses recreation sport transportation business but because of changing conceptions of who cyclists are In On Bicycles Evan Friss traces the colorful and fraught history of cycling in New York City He uncovers the bicycle s place in the city over time showing how it has served as a mirror of the city s changing social economic infrastructural and cultural politics since it first appeared It has been central as when horse drawn carriages shared the road with bicycle lanes in the 1890s peripheral when Robert Moses s car centric vision made room for bicycles only as recreation and aggressively marginalized when Ed Koch s battle against bike messengers culminated in the short lived 1987 Midtown Bike Ban On Bicycles illuminates how the city as we know it today veined with over a thousand miles of bicycle lanes reflects a fitful journey powered and opposed by New York City s people and its politics

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
