and exasperation The fact that the facets of my identity seem to stretch across the Diaspora Equatorial Guinea Nigeria Trinidad and Tobago and the United States means that this journey has not been straightforward It has been treacherous with many frustrating moments when I was not sure how much lower my self esteem could go But it has also been exceedingly rewarding as I stumbled upon new paths to convert each disappointment into an opportunity to grow and become more confident in who I was Sometimes that has meant becoming overzealous in my own self affirmation the tone of my voice taking
