
TOPIC 1: THE SKELETAL SYSTEM

 - Dorsal
 - Cranial (Contains the brain)
 - Vertebral Cavity (contains the spinal cord)
 - Ventral:
 - Thoracic (Contains heart and lungs)
 - Superior mediastinum (superior and medially to lungs)
 - Pleural cavity (lungs)
 - Pericardial cavity (heart)
 - Abdominopelvic
 - Abdominal Cavity



- Skeleton is made up of bones and tissue:
 - 4 Different Types of Bones: (As seen above)
 - Long bones
 - Flat Bones
 - Irregular Bones
 - Short Bones
 - Functions:
 - It is a connective tissued
 - Act as levers for the body
 - Attachment site Goy muscles
 - Crucial for protection and movement
 - Support, migeral and fat storage
 - Cartilage allows smooth contact between two bones (joints)
- Structure of a Long Bone.
 - Longer in one axis in contrast to the other, usually anything rectangular.
 - Proximal Epiphysis:
 - (Growing) Region of the bone closest to the body
 - Diaphysis
 - Middle region of the bone
 - Distal Epiphysis
 - Region of the bone furthest away from the body
 - Articular Cartilage
 - The outermost layer of the proximal epiphysis
 - Spongy bone
 - Not very dense, full of little air bubbles and intended to provide structural cushioning, not support and strength under pressure.

- Compact Bone
 - Very dense and compacted, intended to provide structural stability and not cushioning.
 Relatively only strong in one direction, not intended for critical protection and cushioning.
 - Mainly found in long bones
