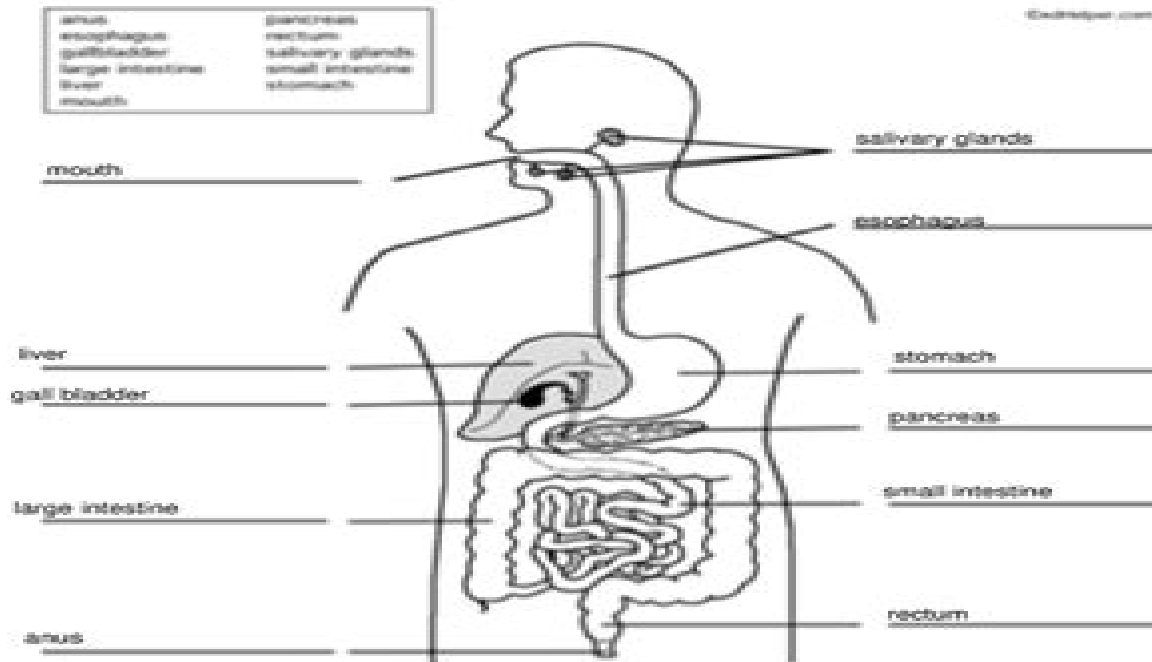

The digestion of food begins in the mouth by the action of the enzyme amylase secreted by the salivary glands. This enzyme begins the breakdown of starch. When you swallow, the epiglottis blocks the entrance to the larynx, and the bolus of food moves down the esophagus by muscular contractions called peristalsis. In the stomach, the action of hydrochloric acid and pepsin (two components of gastric juice secreted by the stomach lining) aid in the breakdown of protein. After leaving the stomach, the acidic mixture of partially digested food, called chyme, enters the
