- 1- No parking is allowed short of the arrow to the corner
- 2- A lane usage road sign authorizing right turn only
- 3- A lane usage road sign allowing all turns

- 1- Bicycles are authorized on this road

- 3- Vehicle stopping is not allowed



Q103/ This Traffic Sign Indicates That:

- 1- Slipping conditions occur when wet
- 2- Road ahead the road with increasing traffic

- 2- The road is clear ahead, if it necessary, yield right of way to approaching vehicles
- 3- You should stop and yield the right-of-way to passing vehicles from both directions
