Setting the some

The manager of a successful brickleying contractor, with help from worker representatives, carried out a general risk assessment that covered their typical work. This assessment was used when tendering for contracts to demonstrate the firm's approach to health and safety. In the tender documents the manager was clear about what was needed from the principal contractor to do the job safety and property.

This firm woon a bricklinying continued for a development of three-storey flats. Work was due to start on 1 May 2006. The manager checked the construction phase plan and met the principal contractor's site manager on the site. This extra information was used to amend the general assessment to that it was specific to the work and openitions.

How was the risk assessment done?

The manager followed the guidance in Five steps to risk assessment (eners/hee-gov-uk/lpubnis/mdg163.pdf).

1. To identify the hazards, the manager:

- 2 The manager then wrote down who could be harmed by the hazards and how.
- 3 For each histard identified, the manager recorded select controls, if any seem in place to manage three histards. These controls were then compared to the good practice guidance laid out in the manufacturers' instructions or the data sheets. Health and subty in construction. Where existing controls did not meet good practice the manager emote down what further actions were needed to manage the risk.
- 4 Putting the findings of the risk assessment into practice, the manager decided and recorded who was responsible for implementing the further actions and when they should be done. When each action was completed it was toked off and the date was recorded.
- 5 The manager decicled that for each new site it was important to make sure the assessment was suitable and amend it depending on the particular work and conditions. A review and update of the general risk assessment would be made each year and staff would leave from the work on different sites.

How was the site-specific risk assessment done?

- To furnithe general risk assessment into a site-specific assessment the manager checked the following had been identified:
- The month hashands:
- who might be harmed and how;
- controls that would need to be taken on this particular site; and
- who would be responsible for putting the controls into practice and when.
- 2. The moreoper did this by:
- checking the construction phase plan for the site.

- visiting the site; and

This example risk assessment shows the kind of approach a small business might take.
