




Hormones: Chemical substances that act as messengers and control metabolic functions in many cells in the body.

- They carry 7-11 the role of cellular functions.
- Are classified as **steroid** or **protein** hormones.
- Steroid hormones, passing through membranes, act on the nucleus to produce protein or enzyme synthesis in the cell.
- Protein hormones, binding to receptors on the cell surface, activate secondary activity.
- Steroid hormones: **Testosterone, Estrogen, Cortisol, Aldosterone, Thyroid hormones.**

Water vs. Lipid Soluble Hormones

Water-soluble hormones bind to a receptor on the plasma membrane, activating a second-messenger system. It produces an obligatory molecule that responds to stimulus and will act in a cell to produce a cellular response.

ENDOCRINE SYSTEM

Endocrinology: the scientific study of hormones and endocrine glands.

Functions

1. Growth and development
2. Metabolic rate, anabolism and catabolism
3. Regulation of reproduction and energy balance
4. Homeostasis

How it works

The endocrine system works with the nervous system to coordinate and integrate cellular activities in the body, via hormones.

- **Endocrine glands** release hormones into the blood stream to stimulate metabolic activities throughout the body.
- Each hormone has a specific function in the body and has its own specific target cells for which the hormone is the substrate by the mechanism.

- 1. Each hormone specifically binds to a **target cell**.
- 2. A target cell has receptors on their cell membrane designed to respond to that specific hormone.
- 3. When the hormone binds to the receptor, the receptor sends a "lock and key" mechanism.
- 4. After the hormone binds to the cell receptor, a chemical chain of events occurs, leading to a hormonal response.



Effectors: target organs or glands that respond to hormones, producing a response.

Endocrine vs. Exocrine Glands

Endocrine Glands	Exocrine Glands
Release hormones directly into the bloodstream.	Release secretions through ducts.
Examples: Hypothalamus, Pituitary, Thyroid, Parathyroid, Adrenal, Pancreas, Gonads.	Examples: Salivary glands, Sweat glands, Mammary glands, Liver, Pancreas.

REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

Reproductive cycle: a series of cycles that occur each month in which the endometrium undergoes changes in response to hormonal activity in the blood.

REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

The **uterine wall** has four layers:

1. **Perimetrium** (outermost)
2. **Myometrium** (muscular layer)
3. **Endometrium** (innermost layer)

External genitalia (the vulva) includes:

1. Labia majora
2. Labia minora
3. Clitoris
4. Vagina
5. Vestibular gland


The **ovary** is the female reproductive organ that produces eggs and secretes hormones.



REPRODUCTIVE SYSTEM

The **reproductive system** functions to produce offspring. Primary sex organs called **gonads** (ovary in females and testis in males) produce gametes (sex cells) and secrete hormones. Accessory organs include ducts, glands, and external genitalia.

Two categories include the **male reproductive system** which produces **sperm**, and the **female reproductive system** which produces **eggs** (ova).



Sexual Phase: each phase of the menstrual cycle involves a change in the uterine lining, a change in the level of hormones, and a change in the body's temperature.

Menstruation: the shedding of the uterine lining, which occurs every 28-35 days.

Ovulation: the release of an egg from the ovary.

Implantation: the attachment of a fertilized egg to the uterine wall.

Pregnancy: the period of development of the fetus in the uterus.

Delivery: the process of giving birth.

Lactation: the production of milk by the mammary glands.
