## DEFINITION

Paraphrasing is the process of the restating someone else's ideas or text using your own words while maintaining the original meaning. It involves changing the structure and wording of the original text while keeping the main ideas intact. It is often used to avoid plagiarism, to clarify the complex text or to tailor the information to the intended audience.
