which have immunological functions The study of polymorphism within the MHC is well established because the region contains the highly polymorphic HLA genes HLA polymorphism has been used extensively in solid organ and bone marrow transplantation to match donors and recipients As a result large numbers of HLA alleles have been identified a process that has been further driven by recent interest in HLA gene diversity in ethnic populations.
