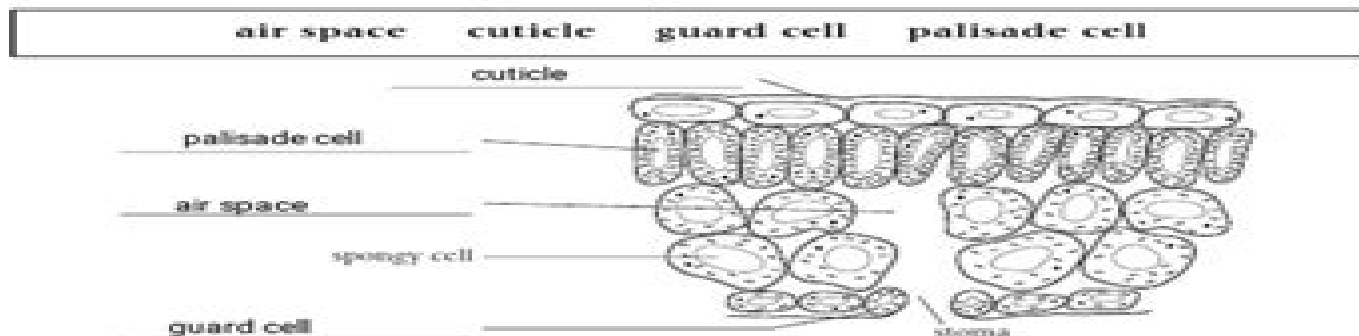

The cuticle is a waterproof layer that stops the leaf losing too much water. The palisade cells have lots of chloroplasts to absorb light energy to make photosynthesis happen. Leaves have a large surface area so they can absorb a lot of light energy. Cells in the leaf need to absorb carbon dioxide from the air. Air gets into the leaf through holes in the bottom surface called stomata. Guard cells can close the stomata at night to stop the leaf losing water.
