

Create a BRD in 10 Steps

Steps to Write a BRD	Description
1. Identify project background	Define the project for which the BRD is being developed.
2. Define objectives	Clearly state the objectives and desired outcomes of the project.
3. Identify and analyze stakeholders	Identify stakeholders and analyze their roles and expectations.
4. Gather requirements	Gather the requirements from stakeholders via meetings, surveys etc.
5. Document assumptions and constraints	Identify any assumptions made during the requirement gathering process and document them.
6. Document functional specifications	Clearly define the functional requirements of the project in detail.
7. Include non-functional requirements	Specify non-functional requirements, such as performance, security, and usability.
8. Prioritize requirements	Identify the most critical requirements and map them out in a logical order.
9. Review and validate the BRD	Thoroughly review and validate the BRD with key stakeholders for accuracy.
10. Obtain stakeholder sign-off	Obtain formal approval from stakeholders, indicating agreement with the BRD.
