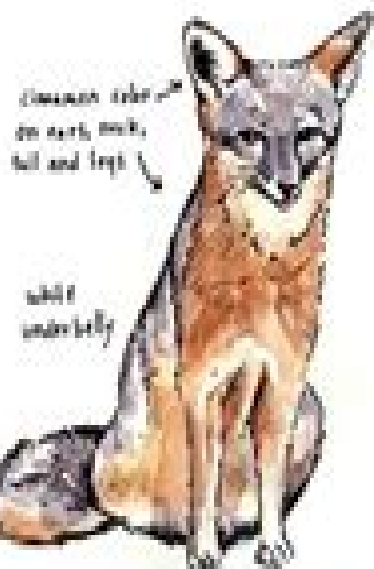

Cinnamon color on back, tail and legs

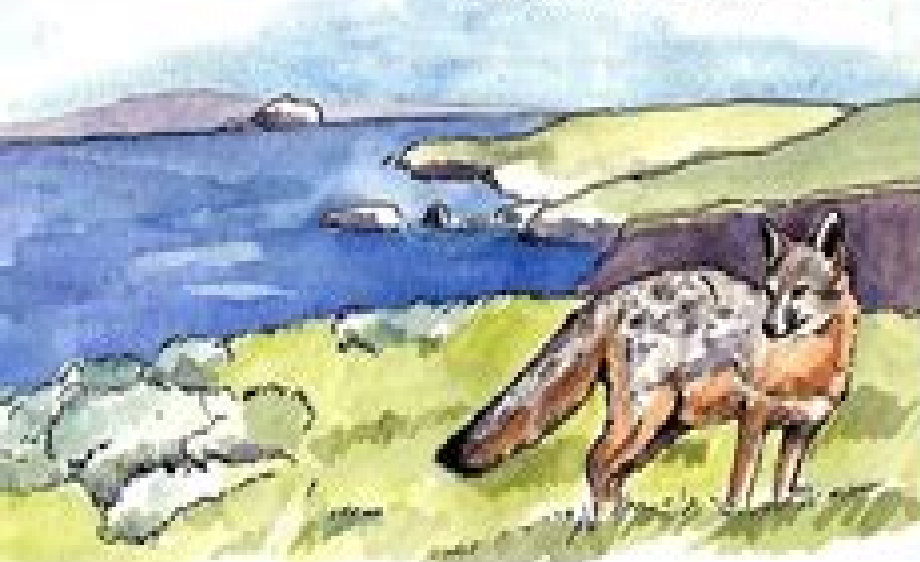

In 1980 the Santa Cruz island fox population was fewer than 100, a 90 percent reduction in just a decade, largely due to predation by non-native golden eagles. The population was stabilized through captive breeding. The golden eagles were released to the mainland and native bald eagles were re-introduced to the island. The current population is greater than 1,300.



The first foxes are believed to have come to the island more than 13,000 years ago, fleeing from the mainland on debris from megaseismic events. Foxes are born in late March through early May. Island foxes eat summer berry, lizard, lizard, mice, small birds and sometimes insects.

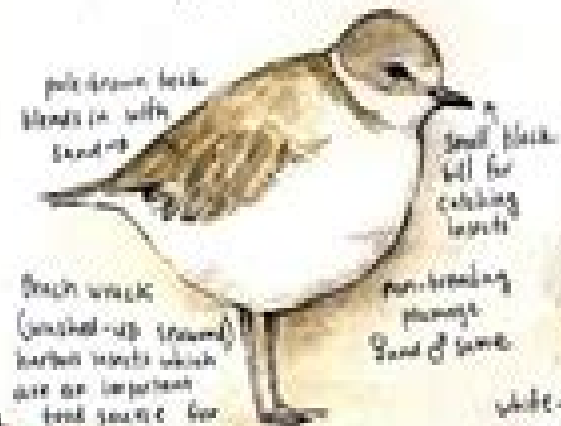

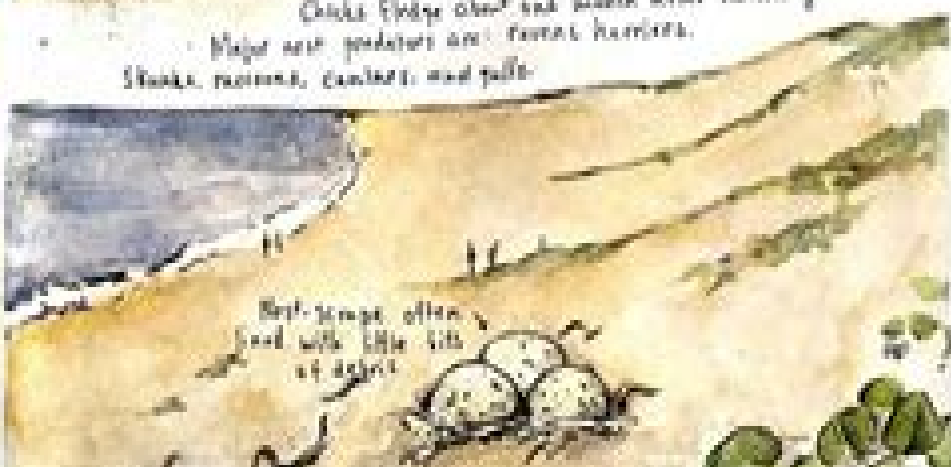
