Writer's use quotation marks to show that they are using other writer's words to elaborate on their ideas.

What to do:

- Set it up. Use a phrase (or a sentence starter) that let's the reader know you are going to use another's words or ideas.
- Use a comma after the sentence starter.
- Put quotation marks around the quotation.
- (Normally punctuation goes inside of the quotation marks, but when you're using someone else's words it's a bit different)
- Use parenthesis and put the author's last name and the page number to show whose words you're using. This is called a citation (Maxwell 42).
- s. Put a period after the citation.
