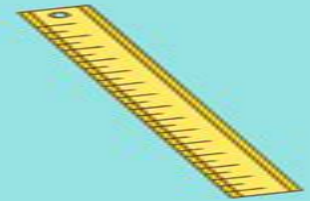


THE BEST STUDY TIPS
