It targets heterogeneous systems by combining finite state machines (FSM) with synchronous dataflow graphs (SDFG). FSMs are connected in the same way as in Argos, a Statecharts variant with purely synchronous semantics using three operators: synchronous parallel, refinement, and hiding. The fourth operator called asynchronous parallel is introduced in DFCharts to connect FSMs with SDFGs. In the formal semantics of DFCharts, the operation of an SDFG is represented as an FSM. Using this representation, SDFGs are merged with FSMs so that the behaviour of a complete DFCharts specification can be expressed as a single flat FSM. This allows system properties to be verified globally.
