

8.4 Life on Earth

1. Analysis of the oldest sedimentary rocks provides evidence for the origin of life

- *Identify the relationship between the conditions on early Earth and the origin of organic molecules (1.2.1)*
- Earth is about 4.6 billion years old.
- Conditions of early Earth:
 - Massive oceans present
 - Only small landmasses above surface of water
 - No ozone layer
 - Strong UV rays from Sun
 - Boiling oceans produced huge amounts of water vapour, making early earth extremely humid.
 - No free oxygen
 - Volcanic activity, heat, ash, dust and gases released into atmosphere
 - Atmosphere anoxic and full of toxic gases. Such as: water vapour (H_2O), methane (CH_4), ammonia (NH_3), carbon dioxide (CO_2), nitrogen (N_2), hydrogen (H_2).
 - Violent lightning storms common
- Description plausible since it matches with:
 - Conditions and chemicals on other planets.
 - The chemicals that erupt from volcanic vents today and probably always have.
- Chemicals of life contained within basic organic compounds:
 - Water
 - Carbohydrates
 - Lipids
 - Proteins
 - Nucleic acids
- These compounds mainly made of carbon, hydrogen, oxygen, nitrogen (CHON).
- Elements needed to create basic organic compounds, already present in atmosphere.
- Lack of ozone layer, frequent electric storms and volcanic activity of early Earth could have provided energy for molecules to form.

- For life to have originated, the following events need to have happened:
 - Required chemicals need to have been formed
 - Chemicals need to have come together in a self-replicating body
 - This body would need to have a form of protection for its contents
 - It had to be able to use an energy source to replicate itself
 - Organic molecules needed for life would have had to be present
 - These organic molecules could have been formed here on Earth, or been sent to Earth from outer space (the cosmos)
