La nature du mal Christian Lehmann, 2015-08-31 T00:00:00+02:00 Andrieu jeune cinaste français malmené par les médias accepte une mission d'Amnesty International en Amérique du Sud pour redorer son image. Il doit rencontrer le colonel De La Pena, ministre de l'Intérieur du nouveau gouvernement de San Felicio, maître absolu de Castel Morro, le lieu où l'on torture et torture les opposants politiques depuis des décennies. Juan De La Pena est réputé pour sa violence, sa cruauté et ses accès de folie. Andrieu redoute cette rencontre, mais quelque chose le pousse qui n'a rien à voir avec ses soucis médiatiques : la curiosité face au mal, au mal absolu. Il y a certaines choses qu'il vaut mieux pouvoir ignorer, lui dit le colonel en guise de préambule. Le jeune journaliste d'Amnesty souhaite-t-il vraiment savoir ? Veut-il connaître la nature du mal ? J'avais quatorze ans. En tout cas, c'est ce qu'indiquent les registres de l'orphelinat où j'avais été placé avec ma sœur. De nos parents, elle ne parlait pas et je n'ai jamais retrouvé nulle trace. Ainsi commence le récit de Juan De La Pena, qui est davantage celui d'un homme brisé que d'un tortionnaire. Quatorze ans, il a été incarcéré à Castel Morro et a été soumis ainsi que sa sœur au supplice dont raffolait le maître des lieux de l'époque, le colonel Guarneri, prendre un prisonnier et lui proposer une tentative d'évasion qui lui coûtait invariablement la vie. La trappe de la liberté s'ouvrait sur une baie infestée de requins. Au moment d'être reconduit dans sa cellule, Juan De La Pena, au bord de la démente, a sauté. Il a sauté comme beaucoup d'autres, mais il est le seul qui ait jamais atteint la rive. Ce livre a reçu le Prix Lire au Collège 1999.
