value of benefits for producers and consumers would be around 850 million Producers from the mid altitude maize zone will be the main beneficiaries given the targeted area of TELA maize Consumers from all areas will benefit from the projected reduction in price If the adoption of this new technology is delayed by 5 years the estimated net present value of benefits will fall by 30 percent These costs underscore the importance of having a regulatory system that is efficient predictable and transparent and ensures that the projected economic benefits are realized
