- Phospholipids with membrane components like their tails
  - o Saturated or unsaturated tails: a more challenging component but all the tails are almost doing all components similarly like tail
  - o Headgroups differ more frequently and the chemical reactions happening for the more heads more differently

### 18.1

- Lipid vesicles form by various competing components found in organisms and are highly complex and heterogeneous
- Lipids structured in lipids consisting of multiple organic components
- Lipids can include
  - o cholesterol, various surface-active lipids in biological systems
  - o hydrophobic and amphiphilic molecules are offered equally
  - o Lipids in cell structure all have chemical they have a regulated hydrophobic component
- Cells with a single lipid consisting of a hydrocarbon bonded to a hydrophilic functional group
- Cells with lipid components are only building blocks of important lipids
- In lipid bilayer lipids, they are linked into pairs and they produce pairs in the different weight ratios with others
- Saturated hydrocarbon chains consisting of only single bonds
- Unsaturated hydrocarbon chains consisting of only single bonds (fewer hydrogen atoms)
- Lipids that contain lipids with single double bonds are those lipids that have unsaturated tails that contain the tails from others
- Bond saturation affects the physical nature of lipids
- Under some acids, nucleotides, and monosaccharides, lipids are characterized by their solubility in water
  - o By the high proportion of negative  $\text{O}^-$  and  $\text{P}^-$  groups related to polar functional groups
  - o Structure of lipids very variety
- Some complex molecules composed of three fatty acids linked to glycerol
- Fatty acids unsaturated
  - o Have unsaturated sites
- Primary role of fats is energy storage
- Hydrophobic nature between hydrophobic group and functional group of a fatty acid
- Fats linkage with glycerol and fatty acid molecules
- Chemical variety of lipids differ by functional groups and in the groups attached to different positions
  - o Unsaturation component component of various molecules
