# RESEARCH PROPOSAL TEMPLATE

When preparing an application for entry into a research higher degree program it is necessary to supply a clear statement describing the proposed area of research (a research proposal). Consultation with a faculty or school academic staff member in the research area of interest is recommended prior to submission of an application. Liaising with an academic allows you to frame the proposal to align with established disciplines and areas of supervisor capacity.

You must write your own research proposal and reference accordingly. The exception is when your potential supervisor finalises the research proposal with you, for a specific research project that has already been defined. Please visit the University's Academic Integrity pages and policy
