



## Properties of Parallel Lines

Vertical Angles: Nonadjacent angles formed by two intersecting lines. **Vertical angle are congruent.**

Corresponding Angles: Two angles in the same position with respect to the transversal, but on a different line. **Corresponding angles are congruent.**

Alternative Interior Angles: Two angles on the interior but on the opposite side of the transversal. **Alternate interior angles are congruent.**



Alternate Exterior Angles: Two angles on the exterior but on the opposite side of the transversal. **Alternate exterior angles are congruent.**

Consecutive (Same Side) Interior Angles: Two angles on the interior and on the same side of the transversal. **Consecutive interior angles are supplementary.**

Consecutive (Same Side) Exterior Angles: Two angles on the exterior and on the same side of the transversal. **Consecutive exterior angles are supplementary.**
