He reviewed science fiction works in *Astounding Science Fiction* from 1945 until 1975. He accumulated one of the largest private collections of science fiction books in his day, roughly 8,000 hardcovers and paperbacks. In 1963, he was presented with a special Hugo for his reviewing. He began as an author of fiction at 18 years old. *The Red Plague* (1930) was one of the more popular and accomplished SF pulp writers of the 1930s.
