In his 1825 book Nature and Reason Harmonized in the Practice of Husbandry John Lorain begins his first chapter by stating that "[v]ery erroneous theories have been propagated" resulting in faulty farming methods (1). His words here create a framework for the rest of his book, as he offers his readers narratives of his own trials and errors and even dismisses foreign, time-tested techniques farmers had held on to: "The knowledge we have of that very ancient and numerous nation the Chinese, as well as the very located habits and costumes of this very singular people, is in itself insufficient to teach us . . .
