was for a time a London banker Austen lived her entire life within a close knit family group very much like the gentry who make up the characters of her novels mainly located in the countryside very much like the settings of her novels In a cruelly ironic twist Austen's family would suffer the fate feared by Mrs Bennet in *Pride and Prejudice* when her father died unexpectedly leaving his wife and unmarried daughters destitute and dependent upon her brothers for support
