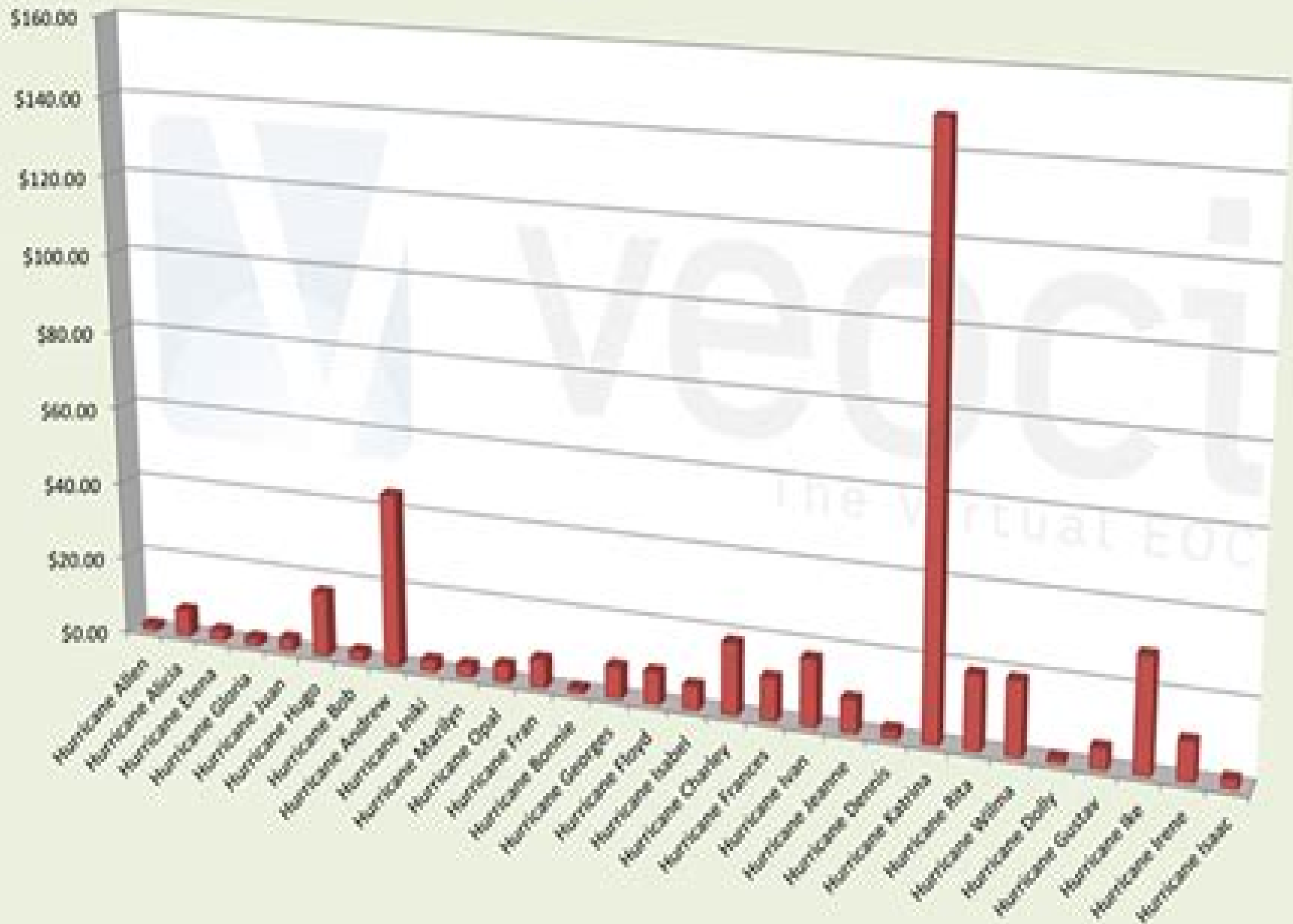


Loss from Hurricanes in the U.S. from 8/1980 to 9/2012 (CPI adjusted)
