- 3.1 Globalisation is a long-standing process which accelerated because of rapid developments in transport, communications and businesses.
  - Globalisation involves widening and deepening global connections, interdependence and flows (commodities, capital, information, migrants and tourists). (1) Use of proportional flow lines showing networks of flows.

GLOBALISATION: variety of ways in which places/people are more connected than in the past

- IMF: Increasing integration around world through movement of goods, services and capital
- World Health Organisation: increased interconnectedness of people and countries.
- The Economist: freer movement of goods, services, ideas and people around world
- In past, global connection achieved through:
  - Trade esp after 1492 when traditional world economy emerged
  - Colonialism end of 19th century, British Empire directly controlled ¼ of the world
  - Co-operation ever since WWI ended, international organisations like UN existed
