Alarm over rising tide of toxic 'forever chemicals'

Pollutants known as "forever chemicals", which build up in the body, may be toxic, and do not break down in the environment - have been found at high levels at thousands of sites across the UK and Europe, the Guardian can reveal.

The major mapping project reveals that per- and polyfluorinated substances (PFAS), a family of about 5,000 chemicals valued for non-stick and detergent properties, have made their way into water, soils and sediments from a wide range of consumer products, including fire-fighting foam, waste and industrial processes.

Two PFAS chemicals have been linked to an array of health problems. PFOS has been associated with kidney and testicular cancer, thyroid disease, ulcerative colitis, high cholesterol and pregnancy-induced hypertension, and PFOS with reproductive, developmental, liver, kidney, and thyroid disease. At lower levels, PFAS has been associated with immunotoxicity. The substances

have been found at about 27,000 sites across the UK and Europe. At about 4,000 of these sites, PFAS have been detected at high concentrations of more than 1,000mg/kg, or one per litre of water. They were found at above 10,000mg/kg in 100 locations.

"These sorts of concentrations raise concerns with me," said Prof Catherine Maxwell, an environmental chemist at Lancaster University. "You have the risk of livestock gaining access to these waters and then PFAS in the human food web."

In the UK, the highest levels of PFAS were found in a discharge from a chemicals plant on the River Wyre, above Blackpool. Fish in the river have been found to contain high levels of PFAS, with numbers increasing up to 21,000mg/kg, according to data from Defra's Centre for Environment, Fisheries and Aquaculture Science.

Prof Ian Cousins, an environmental scientist at Stockholm University, said sites with readings above 1,000mg/kg should be "urgently assessed" so that they can be remediated. "It [highly] recommends, when local authorities should consider testing to make sure that PFAS levels are within local

Russia's grief
Parents in

For almost a month before midnight, a young Russian contractor named Daria, who had been sent to fight in Ukraine, picked up his phone to write a message to his family and friends back home in a small town in the Samara region. It was 10 December. "We congratulated each other, wished each other the best for the new

year, and then he was gone," said a close friend who was messaging with him that night. Minutes later, a 175-grade Russian rocket slammed into Professional Technical School No 29 in Makinska, a city in eastern Ukraine under Russian occupation. It took nearly 50 days for Daria's remains to be identified beneath the rubble. His family spent weeks calling local hospitals and a military hotline, where they were told to wait for news, which never seemed to come. The massive strike, which killed at least 100 soldiers from a single Russian regiment,

most of them conscripted to fight in Vladimir Putin's invasion of Ukraine, highlighted the horror on the Russian front that have been shaken by the war, and how the Kremlin has dipped into a deep well of patriotism and propaganda to maintain its war effort despite the deaths of tens of thousands of Russian soldiers in the past year. The friend, who agreed to speak with the Guardian anonymously, described Daria, in his early 20s, as a soldier who had worked hard in Crimea before returning to his native
