Therefore the decoloniality movement seeks to confront these structural challenges head on via dialogue to ensure the integrity of the journalism profession Decolonising journalism in South Africa is published at a time in which journalism serves a watchdog and a critique of a democratic government and needs to follow a bottom up social justice approach and become a voice to the voiceless Therefore this book seeks to revolutionise the media in a way that even the language of reporting of certain issues needs to be changed to a balanced kind of reporting characterised by principles of no fear or favour **Political Economy of Contemporary** African Popular Culture Kealeboga Aiseng, Israel A.
