In the early beginnings of civilization, Ancient Mesopotamia and Egypt were two of the largest nations in the known world. Before 10,000 BCE, their primary, and probably only, drink was water. Once beer was discovered in Mesopotamia, it was cemented as a step up from water. Water was prone to contamination, but beer was made with boiled water, leaving no unwanted viruses. It slowly made its way to Egypt, where it became just as popular. It even made its way into a story of Egyptian lore involving Ra, the Sun God. At the time, this could be seen as a global phenomenon. Another drink that follows this pattern is brandy. In the heyday of strong alcoholic, like brandy, there was a great market occurring called the Transatlantic Slave Trade. During this time, black slaves were being traded and shipped to America from Africa.
