Many grantmakers permit grant applications by invitation only, and require recipients to submit preliminary proposals in the form of inquiry letters in order to be submit a <u>Full Proposal</u>.

Inquiry letters are designed to convince the grantmaker to consider your request. you the opportunity to give the grantmaker a snapshot of your proposed. focus on detail, clarity, and conciseness, while conveying the impact your the need or problem you are addressing.

- Organization Overview/Purpose
- State Reason for and Amount of Funding Request
- Describe Needs or Problem (including target population, statistics, examples)
- Describe Project or Program
- List other Project Funders (prospective and committed)
- Request Funding Application

The CBO will be the construction and property manager for the project.
