The term "ISI tournal" doesn't really mean anything anymore, since "ISI" was removed when Thomson Reuters changed the name from ISI Web of Knowledge to Web of Science. But given that, then yes, if a journal is indexed in the WoS than it is what used to be called an ISI journal.
