Excerpt from The Latter Day Saints Millennial Star Vol 84 November 9 1922 President Grant said it was a source of great satisfaction to him to see such a large attendance He said he had no recollection of any opening of conference on a week day when some of those attending had to stand He was grateful to see so many present hoped all would be fed on the bread of life and that whatever he said would be for the good of himself and the congregation When the Opening prayer was made he said and a supplication went up to God that law and order might be upheld he knew what the keynote should be President Grant then read a selection from the Doctrine and Covenants to the effect that laws and rulers should be upheld and order maintained That he said meant that men should be able to labor without running the risk of being killed by someone who
