ABOUT THE EXAM

The examination for English Language Arts and Reading 8, First Semester consists of 73 questions, of which 54 are multiple choice and matching, and the rest are short answer and essay. The exam is based on the Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) for this subject. The full list of TEKS is included in this document (it is also available online at the [Texas Education Agency website](https://education.texas.gov/teks)). The TEKS outline specific topics covered in the exam, as well as more general areas of knowledge and levels of critical thinking. Use the TEKS to focus your study in preparation for the exam. TEKS covered in this semester are indicated by a checkmark; the exam will focus on the checkmarked TEKS, but may touch on any of the full list.

The examinations will take place under supervision, and the recommended time limit is three hours. You may not use any notes or books. A percentage score from the examination will be reported to the official at your school.

PRE-EXAM ASSIGNMENTS

You are required to read *The Call of the Wild* by Jack London (any unabridged edition) outside of the testing environment before you take the CBE. You should also be familiar with basic biographical information about the author and the time period in which this work was written. **You will not be able to pass the CBE without completing these tasks.**
