INTRODUCTION

Mild cognitive impairment (MCI) is the widely used term that describes an intermediate stage from normal cognitive function to dementia. The concept of MCI is highly significant and important to the field of aging and dementia for several reasons. Subjects with MCI have a high rate of progression to dementia over a relatively short period. Even among subjects who revert to normal cognition, the rate of subsequent MCI or dementia is higher than among those who never develop MCI. Research related to MCI provides insights into disease mechanisms in the predementia stage of disease.
