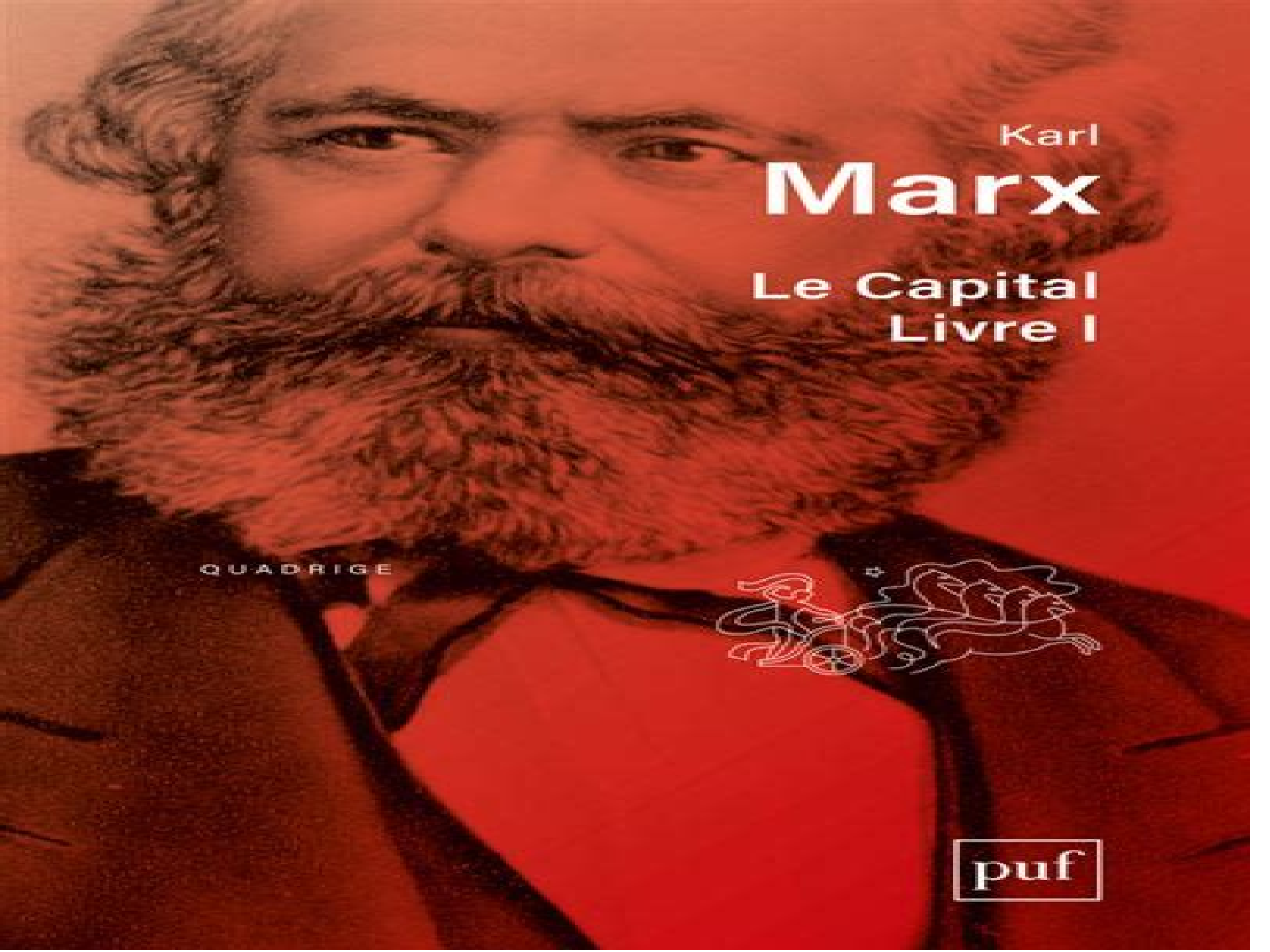

Le Capital - Livre illustré - tome 1 Karl Marx, 2023-02-16 Il est des livres qui changent le monde La première publication du Capital de Karl Marx en 1867 à Hambourg n'a rencontré aucun succès immédiat mais a eu quelques années plus tard un retentissement croissant dans la Russie des Tsars allant jusqu'à son renversement quelques décennies après. L'idée phare de ce livre qui véhicule une pensée simple mais ardue est que le capitalisme est un système instable aliénant les êtres humains générant des conflits entre nations provoquant troubles et misères sur la base de l'expropriation de la force de travail des travailleurs par les bourgeois via le principe du salariat. Ce livre qu'on aime ou qu'on le déteste a profondément bouleversé l'ordre établi et on en voit encore les conséquences aujourd'hui en Russie mais aussi en Chine ou en Corée du Nord. Memoria Books présente une version illustrée du Capital en deux tomes offrant une double grille de lecture. Le texte original de Marx d'une part et parallèlement 89 illustrations dont 45 dans le tome 1 qui représentent au fil de la lecture les conséquences travers le temps de ce texte. Les premières illustrations retracent le contexte de l'époque puis petit à petit apparaissent les conséquences que ce livre a eues sur le monde. Toutes les illustrations sont réalisées par Yoann Laurent Rouault maître diplômé des Beaux-Arts de Rennes tandis que la préface du tome 1 est l'œuvre de Jean-David Haddad professeur agrégé de Sciences économiques et sociales, auteur, chroniqueur.

Il regroupe les cinq publications suivantes : *Marx en 60 minutes*, *Nietzsche en 60 minutes*, *Freud en 60 minutes*, *Sartre en 60 minutes* et *Camus en 60 minutes*. La pensée de ces philosophes y est présentée de manière concise et soumise à la question suivante : quoi nous servent ces idées aujourd'hui ? Mais avant tout, la parole est donnée aux philosophes eux-mêmes. Ainsi, les thèses principales de chaque penseur sont appuyées par 40 à 160 citations mises en valeur sous forme de bulles, et dont les références bibliographiques précises sont indiquées. Le parti pris d'une présentation à la fois ludique et rigoureuse d'un point de vue scientifique permet au lecteur de se familiariser avec les grandes questions de notre vie. Car tous les grands philosophes ayant marqué l'histoire de la pensée ont soulevé la question du sens de la vie. Quels sont les principes qui gouvernent notre existence ? Les réponses données sont très différentes. Pour Marx, ce sont les rapports de production, c'est-à-dire les conditions dans lesquelles nous travaillons et produisons des biens qui déterminent notre vision des choses, notre esprit et notre culture. Pour Nietzsche, c'est la volonté de puissance qui imprègne notre vie et nous anime. Pour Freud, c'est la libido et donc l'énergie pulsionnelle que nous pouvons assouvir, refouler ou sublimer. Pour Sartre, c'est le libre arbitre absolu qui force les hommes à devenir ce qu'ils sont. Camus est le seul philosophe dans cette collection qui n'offre pas de réponse à la question du sens de notre existence. Car, selon Camus, il n'y en a pas : la vie est tant absurde et dépendante d'une succession de hasards. Ainsi, la question du sens du monde et donc du sens de la vie est appréhendée de manière très différente par chaque penseur, mais une chose est sûre : de sa perspective respective, chacun des cinq philosophes a fait jaillir une tincelle de vérité. *Le Capital* Karl MARX, 2017-09-17.
