## **HIPAA Compliance Policy**

#### 1. Purpose

This HIPAA Compliance Policy is designed to ensure that [Organization Name] adheres to the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) of 1996 and the subsequent amendments, including the Health Information Technology for Economic and Clinical Health (HITECH) Act.
