

The classical wave function is then shown to have exactly the same mathematical properties as the quantum mechanical wave function including the fact that the absolute value squared of the classical wave function has the mathematical properties of a probability density However the interpretation that this is a probability density for the particle is shown not to hold Lastly the missing matter problem is resolved by showing that the dynamics and the mass of a spiral galaxy are better and more naturally explained by using ordinary physics with ordinary interacting matter than they are by postulating and using exotic weakly interacting dark matter.
