Direct Object

The direct object of a verb is the thing being acted upon.

- She kicked **the stone**.
- The boss explained **the terms**.
- Dogs eat **meat**.
- Gary loves **Teri**.
- I love **shortbread**.
- They have played **a new game**.

Indirect Object

The indirect object is the recipient of the action (usually, it's a person).

- Give **him** the gold.
- He gave **Amelia** the ball.
- The boy gave **the girl** some food.
- I wrote **him** an email.
- Yasmine bought **Riley** a gift.
- Samara drove **Jill** to the party.

Object of a Preposition

The noun (or pronoun) governed by a preposition is known as the object of a preposition.

- We live in **Manchester**.
- The boy gave gifts **to the girl**.
- I watched TV **with her**.
- Yasmine bought a gift **for Riley**.
- Tommy lives near **a bank**.
- He plays football **with his dad**.
