Chapter 7 Discussion Questions

These discussion questions are all designed for students who have already completed the questions for close reading. Alternatively, if your students are strong readers, you could try doing these discussions without spending time on the questions in class. No matter which option you choose, make sure to reread key passages whenever possible. Students should always be encouraged to answer questions based on the text rather than their memories.

 The story of Biloxi broadens the theme of liars and con artists. What point do these two stories make about why people are easily decrived by others? What point do they make about how we construct our identities, especially as they relate to others?

Fitzgerald points out the way that people feel hunt or taken advantage of when they are lied to, but he also points out how those who believe the lies are often as much to blame as the lians. One thing that's interesting to note is that the characters don't seem very upset about Biloxi's lies, and yet Daisy might be deciding to choose Tim over Gatsby because she is made aware of traths about him. They also tend to believe what they want to believe about the other characters. Tom wants to believe that he is in control of his life, so he doesn't malize that Daisy is cheating on him for a while. Nick never mentions to Jordan that he remembers the scandal of her lying at a goil tournament. Nick laughs at Gatsby's stories about the rubies and traveling around Europe, and yet he never confronts him about it. And when Gatsby explains how he is an "Outord man," Nick is relieved again. Ultimately, Fitzgerald seems to be saying that we believe what we want to believe and what's most convenient to believe, about ourselves and others.

Is chapter 7 the climax of the novel? If so, what event has the reader anticipated? What comes to light about the themes or ideas of the book when examined in this way?

The climax is the event that the reader waits and waits for—in this case, that event would be a confrontation between Tom and Gatsby and/or the truth about Gatsby's past. If the climax of the novel were chapter 5, then this would be a book about romantic love and reunions. Chapter 7 has bleaker ideas. This is a chapter about restoring people to their "rightful" place in society—about restoring the class lines that separate the upper class from the others. Additionally, this is the most violent chapter in the book. The woman who aspired to climb above her station, Myotle, is violently punished for that desire. Gatsby, another climber who thought that he could be with someone as upperclass as Daisy, is also put in his place. In fact, Tom is so secure in his station and his control by the time they leave New York that he doesn't even case if Gatsby and Daisy ride together. In short, for all of his criticism of the upper class and the values of money, Fitagerald is actually quite conservative in the end. The climax in chapter 7 makes this more a book about conformations, violence, and conservative ideas and much much less about love.
