According to Giger and Davidhizer (2000), although cultures differ, they all have the same basic organizing factors that must be assessed in order to provide care for culturally diverse patients. These factors include - communication (verbal and nonverbal);

personal space; social organization; time perception; environmental control; and biological variations.
